This is how the Seed Swap will work

- 1) Sort through your seed collection and put aside any that you don't think you are going to use or are surplus to requirements. You can bring, to swap, any packets of commercially produced seeds but please nothing out of date. However the odd open packet is also welcome.
- 2) If you save your own seed - clearly label, date and packet them up - an old envelope makes a good seed packet.
- 3) Come along to the **Bear Flat Community Market** on **Saturday 21 February** at the **Methodist Hall**, Bruton Avenue, Bear Flat **BA2 4QJ** between 10 – 12. Don't forget to bring your seeds for swapping with you.
- 4) Find the seed swap table in the market
- 5) Swap your seeds for somebody else's and walk away with something new or an old favourite to grow this year – for **free**
- 6) If you see a packet of seed you particularly fancy but have nothing to swap a 50p donation per packet is acceptable.
- 7) After the pleasant seed swapping experience you can wander round the market purchasing the delights on offer – fresh baked bread, pickles, jams, gifts and vegetables - ending up with cup of tea a well earned piece of homemade cake and a chat with your new found friends.
- 8) Bring your children and they can cut and paste and make to their hearts content, with Margarida in charge, at the craft table while you are busy swapping and shopping (There will be a small fee to cover the cost of materials, with any remainder going to Bath-based NGO, EthiopiAid)
